It has been a little over a year since we established our Hands and Feet ministry. Our goal was to grow as a church in our service to others. We decided to join forces with the Regional Food Bank of Oklahoma by dedicating one Wednesday a month. In our efforts from April to September, we were able to help package 35,613 pounds of food; an equivalent to 29,677 meals.

The experience was amazing and it led us to want to expand. It was in September when our ministry began serving the homeless community in downtown Oklahoma City. We started by making and serving 45 meals, which now has grown to 100 meals on Wednesday nights. Our ministry has been able to serve these meals with the help of many caring local businesses and loving people who have heard of our cause and decided to lend a hand. Prayers, clothing, meals and much more are

what our service is able to provide. Please continue to pray for Hands and *Feet* so that it may continue to give fruit. And if you would like to help in any way, your help will be greatly appreciated.
